

25. Policy on Change of Name

The Accrediting Commission requires that when an institution proposes to change its name, it must notify the Executive Director in writing *prior* to making the change. The institution must include a proposed date when the new name will be used.

The Commission will review the proposed new name, and reserves the right to approve or not approve it for cause. The institution must also provide documentation (when it's available) that it has notified the appropriate state governing and licensing authorities concerning the change of name.

The institution must also update its Teach-Out Commitment (E.8. or E.9.) and file a copy with the Commission.
