WHAT IS DISTANCE EDUCATION?

Distance education, also called online education for Internet-based learning, is designed for learners who live at a distance from educational providers and/or institutions. It is the enrollment and study with an educational institution that provides organized, formal learning opportunities for students. Presented in a sequential and logical order, the instruction is offered wholly or primarily by distance study, through virtually any media. Historically, its predominant medium of instruction has been printed materials, however, it may incorporate or make use of videotapes, CD or DVD ROM's, audio recordings, facsimiles, telephone communications, e-mail, and Web-based delivery systems through the Internet. The student completes each lesson or segment and submits it for correction, grading, comment, and guidance by a qualified instructor. Corrected assignments are returned to the student. This exchange fosters a personalized student-instructor relationship, which is the hallmark of distance education instruction.

Distance education courses vary greatly in scope, level, and length. Some have a few lessons and require only weeks to complete, while others have a hundred or more assignments requiring many years of conscientious study.

ADVANTAGES OF DISTANCE EDUCATION

Distance education is especially suited for busy people who wish to increase their knowledge and skills. With distance education, you do not have to give up your job, leave home or lose income. You learn as you earn. The school comes to you. You receive individual attention, and often you work at your own pace.

Emphasis is on learning what you need to know. Instructional materials are up-to-date, clearly written and easy to understand.

WHAT ACCREDITATION MEANS

Historically, accreditation fosters excellence in education through the development of standards for assessing educational effectiveness. Accreditation is a process of self-evaluation in which an institution voluntarily monitors and controls its own behavior to ensure that its programs and policies embody standards of good practices. The process includes a rigorous on-site verification examination of a committee of peer reviewers and independent experts who judge the institution on whether or not it meets the standards of accreditation. Accreditation encourages improvement through continuous self-evaluation and planning, and it assures the educational community, students, state and federal authorities, interested agencies, and organizations and the general public that an institution has clearly defined appropriate objectives and maintains conditions under which its achievement can be expected.

Distance education accreditation is certification by a recognized body that a distance education institution has undergone a comprehensive study and peer examination that demonstrates that the institution does in fact meet the established standards. An institution must:

- have a clearly defined and stated mission and objectives;
- have reasonably attainable and clearly stated educational objectives, and educationally sound and up-to-date programs;
- provide satisfactory educational services;
- offer satisfactory student services;
- have demonstrated ample student satisfaction and achievement;
- document student attainment of learning outcomes;

- have a competent faculty, administrators, and staff;
- have fair admission policies and adequate enrollment agreements;
- advertise its programs truthfully;
- be financially able to deliver high quality educational programs;
- have fair and equitable tuition refund policies;
- have adequate facility, equipment and record protection; and
- conduct continuous research and self-improvement studies.

DETC ACCREDITING COMMISSION

The Distance Education and Training Council was founded in 1926 under the name “National Home Study Council.” As a voluntary association of what were then known as correspondence schools, the Council decided to further improve its procedures for membership, and in 1955 the Accrediting Commission was formed.

The DETC Accrediting Commission performs the institutional accrediting functions of the Distance Education and Training Council. Its mission is to promote, by means of standard-setting, evaluation, and consultation processes, the development and maintenance of high educational and ethical standards in education and training programs delivered through distance learning. The DETC Accrediting Commission identifies and accredits distance education and training institutions that have attained and maintained the established standards. Its accrediting program employs procedures similar to those of other nationally recognized accrediting associations.

SCOPE AND RECOGNITION

The DETC Accrediting Commission’s scope is the accreditation of institutions offering programs primarily by the distance education method up through the first professional degree level.

The DETC Accrediting Commission is recognized by the U.S. Secretary of Education and the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA). Recognition by the U.S. Department of Education and CHEA are for postsecondary programs purposes *only*. Since the U.S. Secretary’s authority is statutorily limited to postsecondary institutions in the United States, DETC’s federal recognition extends only to those institutions.

DETC’s scope of recognition by the U.S. Secretary of Education is: *The accreditation of postsecondary institutions in the United States that offer degree programs primarily by the distance education method from the associates up to and including the professional doctoral degree, and are specifically certified by the agency as accredited for Title IV purposes; and the accreditation of postsecondary institutions in the United States not participating in Title IV that offer programs primarily by the distance education method up through the professional doctoral degrees.*

DETC’s scope as recognized by CHEA is: *The accreditation of higher learning institutions that offer programs of study that are delivered primarily by distance (51 percent or more) through distance learning and award credentials through the master’s and first professional degrees.*
